Purchased: We purchased the coach in February 2014 with 148,000 miles on it. In May of 2016 the coach has about 168,000 miles and has been completely renovated. We have enjoyed the coach and are now looking to move on to a newer Prevost.

Interior Renovation:

Blinds: We replaced and automated the interior blinds in the salon so with a single push of a button, the front salon blinds can be raised and lowered. We also upgraded the front blinds.

Valances: The old valances were somewhat dated so we replaced with the fabric a nice neutral look that blends better with the rest of the coach. We also had a custom headboard built for the queen sized bed to go along with the new valances.

Bedsread: We had a bedsread custom made to fit the new tempurpedic mattress. We also had matching cushions made to go along with the new valances.

Wine and Glasses cabinet: We installed a storage cabinet which holds 8 bottles of wine as well as 8 wine glasses and 6 water tumblers.

New salon cabinetry: We removed a couch from the passenger side of the salon and added a full size working desk which has three large drawers. One of the drawers serves as a tray to hold a scanner/printer. We also replaced a decorative cabinet with some pantry space and added a side arm rest with two drawers next to the salon couch.

Hardware: We replaced almost all the interior drawer and wall plate hardware with a more modern style.

Electronics/Entertainment: The rear view camera was replaced with new camera and viewing screen. The Bose speakers in the main salon were wired to a new entertainment components area behind the bedroom TV. A new Pioneer receiver was installed to drive the Bose speakers and the control the entertainment system. The coach already had a Winegard satellite dish which was in good working order so we added the components needed for that dish to connect with the latest DirecTV receivers. A new flat screen TV was installed in the bedroom with a custom hinge that allows it to act as a door to allow servicing the entertainment system. We added a DVD and Apple TV to the system. The system is controlled in the bedroom or the salon using a Control 4 system that we installed. The salon TV was replaced with a 4K TV. We ran Ethernet cat 6 cable from the components cabinet to the desk and the front TV. We installed a Cradlepoint COR IBR600 Series router for our Internet connection. This router just needs a chip from your wireless carrier in order to provide the coach Ethernet network with access to 3G/4G internet while you are on the road.

Tires: In March of 2014 all new tires were put on the coach. The front tires were upgraded to the 365s which provide a better ride in the coach.

House Batteries: All new house batteries were added in February 2016.

Over the road air: The coach has Prevost factory installed over-the-road air conditioning and heating which make cooling and heating the coach as you travel down the road very easy, very reliable and

serviceable at any Prevost service center. Very few Prevost bus conversions have the Prevost factory installed system for heating and cooling the coach.

AC/Heating: In March of 2014 two new air conditioning/heating units were installed to replace the defective units that came with the coach. These allow for heating and cooling the coach while plugged in to shore power.

Water Pump: New water pump installed in January 2016

Inverters: Two new inverters installed in March 2014.

Slides Serviced: Maintenance and repairs done on both bedroom and salon slides in the last two years.

Engine Service: Complete annual inspection and service performed on the coach in November 2015.
